Usamos o Present Perfect para falar de uma ação que já ocorreu sem um tempo determinado e o verbo HAS é utilizado, nesse caso, porque Rose seria substituída pelo pronome SHE.

02. D

Em perguntas, nos tempos perfeitos, colocamos os auxiliares HAS/ HAVE/HAD no início da frase e passamos o VERBO PRINCIPAL para o particípio passado.

03. A

No PAST CONTINUOUS, a estrutura de frase na afirmativa é SUJEITO + WAS/WERE + PRESENT PARTICIPLE (VERBO + ING) + COMPLEMENTO.

04. A

Como o sujeito está no plural e a ação ainda não acabou, usamos HAVEN'T como verbo auxiliar.

05. B

Quando uma atividade acontece antes de uma outra utilizamos o Past Perfect. Primeiro ele escreveu uma canção para depois cantar.
