We were in. / We were not in.

j) You are my brother.

You were my brother. / You were not my brother.

Tim and Peter were in the library. ⇒ **Were Tim and Peter in the library? No, they weren't.**

Was mum ill last week? – Yes, she was.

10) Frank Sinatra was a famous actor.

Was Frank Sinatra a famous actor? – Yes, he was.
