- I am / I'm sorry, what was your name again?

Perguntando a idade:

- How old are you?
- I am / I'm 30 (thirty) (I am / I'm 30 (thirty) years old) - formal

Perguntando a profissão:

- What do you do? / What do you do for a living?
- I am / I'm a Teacher

Formal questions:

- What is / What's your job?
- What is / What's your occupation?

More examples:

- I'm a Lawyer
- I'm an Architect

Mencionando o local:

- I work at a bank
- I work at a library
- I work at school

Caso a empresa seja conhecida:

- I work for Google
- I work for Facebook

Perguntando o phone number:

What is / What's your phone number?
 (Maneira formal, porém pode ser um pouco invasiva em algumas situações)



- Could I get your phone number?
- Sure, my phone number is (203) 999-7777
- Sure, it's (203) 999-7777

Perguntando o e-mail address:

- Could I get your e-mail address?
- Sure, my e-mail address is mrteacherpaulo@gmail.com
- Sure, it's mrteacherpaulo@gmail.com

Perguntando onde mora

(ON= ruas/ IN cidade, estado, país/ AT= endereço completo)

- Where do you live?
- I live on Greene Street / I live in New York City
- What is your address?
- I live at 55 (fifty-five) Greene Street, in New York City
- Where are you from?
- I am / I'm from Brazil
- I'm from Rio de Janeiro I'm Brazilian

Finalizando o diálogo:

- Nice to meet you!
- Nice to meet you, too

Modo formal:

- It's a pleasure to meet you!
- It's a pleasure to meet you, too
- Likewise. (igualmente)
