Eating out in the United States

Trying new food and restaurants is one of the most pleasurable parts of traveling and one of the most common situations where you will need to tip. If you are sitting down to a meal at restaurant with wait staff, tipping is always expected, without exception. The only time you wouldn't leave a tip would be in the case of terrible service. The customary tip is anywhere between 15 to 20 percent of the total bill, but there is nothing stopping you from giving more or less. An average might be around 18% for a satisfactory meal. Americans typically take into account the quality of service when determining gratuity, not how much they liked the food. Feel free to leave a smaller or bigger tip based on how you felt about the service.
