THOUGH: (DÔU) - Informal e usado mais no fim de uma frase.

I could understand it very well, though the lesson was very hard.

EVEN THOUGH: (IVANDÔU) - Mais formal para enfatizar um fato com uma grande diferença.

Even though the lesson was easy, I couldn't understand it very well.

ALTHOUGH THOUGH TOUGH THROUGH

TOUGH: (TÁF) Usado para expressar algo difícil, muitas vezes de forma informal.

*Although my life was **tough**, I could overcome all my hurdles.*

*My father was a **tough** man, he never gave up.*

*The test was **tough**, I passed it though.*

THROUGH: (TRÚ) Usado para expressar algo que “passa” por outro.

*She went **through** tough moments in her life.*

*If you go **through** this way you will reach that building.*

*The city grew a lot **through** the past ten years.*
