Used to é usado:

- Para expressar um hábito do passado;
- somente no passado;
- seguido de um verbo no infinitivo.

Ex:

I used to swim in the river years ago.

Did you use to swim in the river years ago?

I didn't use to swim in the river years ago.

To be used to é usado:

- para expressar um costume;
- no presente, passado e futuro;
- seguido de um verbo com terminação (-ing) ou seguido de objeto direto.

Ex:

He is used to working in the morning.

I am used to the noise of the industry.

Are they used to going to school by bus?

We aren't used to the new teacher.
