### How to make a 911 call

1. Make sure the situation you are calling about is an actual **emergency**.
2. Say, "I need **help**." Then, state your full name and complete **address**, including the number and street.
3. If you are really stressed or upset, take a deep **breath** and **slow down** your speech.
4. If the operator doesn't **understand** you, repeat as many times as necessary.
5. Explain the **problem** in as much detail as possible. If you have a **child**, say his or her age.
6. Try to describe exactly what happened before you called. For example, if your person has a nosebleed, describe if it is light or **severe**, and what activities during the day may have caused it. If the person has low blood **pressure**, describe what he or she ate and drank the day before.
7. Remember, do not **hang up** the phone. Stay on the line as long as needed.
8. Tell the **operator** who else is with you and if anyone is hurt or not breathing because they are **unconscious**.
9. Decide if you need an **ambulance** or first-aid **responders**, and tell the operator if you do. If not, bring the person who is hurt to emergency **care** immediately.
