How to make a 911 call

- 1. Make sure the situation you are calling about is an an actual emergency.
- 2. Say, "I need help." Then, state your full name and complete address, including the number and street.
- 3. If you are really stressed or upset, take a deep breath and slow down your speech.
- 4. If the operator doesn't understand you, repeat as many times as necessary.
- 5. Explain the problem in as much detail as possible. If you have a child, say his or her age.
- 6. Try to describe exactly what happened before you called. For example, if your person has a nosebleed, describe if it is light or severe, and what activities during the day may have caused it. If the person has low blood pressure, describe what he or she ate and drank the day before.
- 7. Remember, do not hang up the phone. Stay on the line as long as needed.
- 8. Tell the operator who else is with you and if anyone is hurt or not breathing because they are unconscious.
- 9. Decide if you need an ambulance or first-aid responders, and tell the operator if you do. If not, bring the person who is hurt to emergency care immediately.
