*"fetched" é o passado do verbo "fetch", que significa "ir buscar algo".
Exemplos:*

Could you fetch me my bag?
Você poderia pegar (e me trazer) minha bolsa?

Wait here while I fetch the doctor.
Espere aqui enquanto eu vou buscar o médico.

He began to chop the beanstalk.
Ele começou a cortar o pé de feijão.

"chop" significa "cortar em pedaços". Exemplos:

He was chopping logs.
Ele estava cortando toras de madeira.

Chop the carrots into small pieces.
Corte as cenouras em pequenos pedaços.

The giant fell and died.
O gigante caiu e morreu.

"fell" (caiu) é o passado de "fall" (cair). E "died" (morreu) é o passado de "die" (morrer).
