

Nessa aula você aprenderá a como fazer frases negativas usando o *verb to be*, que fazemos, simplesmente ao colocarmos o *not* depois do *verbo to be* que estivermos usando na frase.

A forma negativa do verbo *to be* também possui suas formas abreviadas.

**Vejamos cada um deles em suas formas negativas e abreviadas.**

I AM NOT (I'M NOT)

YOU ARE NOT ( YOU AREN'T)

HE IS NOT ( HE ISN'T)

SHE IS NOT (SHE ISN'T)

IT IS NOT ( IT ISN'T)

WE ARE NOT ( WE AREN'T)

THEY ARE NOT ( THEY AREN'T)

**Aqui você precisa aprender somente as formas abreviadas negativas** usando o **verbo to be are e is** sendo que o primeiro fica como ***aren't* (arent)** e o segundo ***isnt* (izânt)**

Vejamos os exemplos:

I am + not = I'm not a teacher ( I AM = I'M)

You are + not = You aren't a teacher ( YOU

ARE NOT = YOU AREN'T)

I am + not = I'm not a teacher ( I AM = I'M NOT A TEACHER)

You are + not = You aren't a teacher ( YOU

ARE NOT = YOU AREN'T A TEACHER)

He is + not = He isn't a student ( HE IS NOT = HE ISN'T A TEACHER)

She is + not = She isn't a teacher ( SHE IS NOT = SHE ISN'T A TEACHER)

It is + not = It's not a teacher ( It is = It isn't A TEACHER)

We are + not = We aren't teachers ( WE ARE NOT = WE AREN'T A TEACHER)

You are + not = You aren't a teacher ( YOU ARE NOT = YOU AREN'T A TEACHER)

They are + not = They aren't teachers ( THEY ARE NOT = THEY AREN'T TEACHERS)
