Nessa aula você aprenderá a como fazer frases negativas usando o verb to be, que fazemos, simplesmente ao colocarmos o not depois do verbo to be que estivermos usando na frase.

A forma negativa do verbo to be também possui suas formas abreviadas.

Vejamos cada um deles em suas formas negativas e abreviadas.

```
I AM NOT (I'M NOT)

YOU ARE NOT ( YOU AREN'T)

HE IS NOT ( HE ISN'T)

SHE IS NOT (SHE ISN'T)

IT IS NOT ( IT ISN'T)

WE ARE NOT ( WE AREN'T)

THEY ARE NOT ( THEY AREN'T)
```

Aqui você precisa aprender somente as formas abreviadas negativas usando *o verbo to be are e is* sendo que o primeiro fica como *aren t* (arent) e o segundo *isnt* (ízânt)

Vejamos os exemplos:

```
I am + not = I'm not a teacher (IAM = I'M)

You are + not = You aren't a teacher (YOU

ARE NOT = YOU AREN'T)

I am + not = I'm not a teacher (IAM = I'M NOT A TEACHER)

You are + not = You aren't a teacher (YOU

ARE NOT = YOU AREN'T A TEACHER)
```

```
He is + not = He isn't a student (HE IS NOT= HE ISN'T A TEACHER)
```

```
She is + not = She isn't a teacher (SHE IS
NOT = SHE ISN'T A TEACHER)
```

```
It is + not = It's not a teacher ( It is = It isn't A TEACHER)
```

```
We are + not = We aren't teachers (WE ARE
NOT = WE AREN'T A TEACHER)

You are + not = You aren't a teacher (YOU
ARE NOT = YOU AREN'T A TEACHER)

They are + not = They aren't teachers (THEY ARE NOT = THEY
AREN'T TEACHERS)
```
