QUESTION/ANSWER: **Going through Immigration**

IMMIGRATION OFFICER: Hello, passport please.

IMMIGRATION OFFICER: What's your occupation? What do you do for work in Brazil?

YOU: I'm an accountant. I've been at this job for the past ten years.

IMMIGRATION OFFICER: Alright, well I hope you enjoy your trip. Have a nice stay.

YOU: Thank you. Have a nice day.
