- h) We will have no bread tomorrow. We **will have eaten** all that bread by tomorrow. (*eat*)
- i) They will be in the middle of the journey when they reach York. They **will have done** half of the journey in York. (*do*)
- j) If you don't hurry, you won't meet anyone at the party.
