Nice to meet you.

Exemplo: Hi, Lucas. Nice to meet you.
Nice to meet you too.
It's a pleasure to meet you.

GREETINGS

To say the name

Exemplo: What's **(what is)** your name?

My name is Lucas, but you can call me brother

What's **(what is)** his name?

His name is Pedro. You can call him Pê,
because his nickname is Pê.

What's **(what is)** her name?

Her name is Giovana, but you can call her Gi,
because her nickname is Gi.

GREETINGS

To say the age

Exemplo: How old are you?

I am 21 years old. I'm 21 years old.

How old is he?

He's 45 years old.

How old are they?

Lucas is 21 and Paulo is 25 years old.

GREETINGS

To say the nationality

Exemplo: Where are you from?
I'm from Brazil. I'm brazilian

Where is she from?
She's from the United States. She's american

Where are we from?
We're from Japan. We're japanese.

GREETINGS

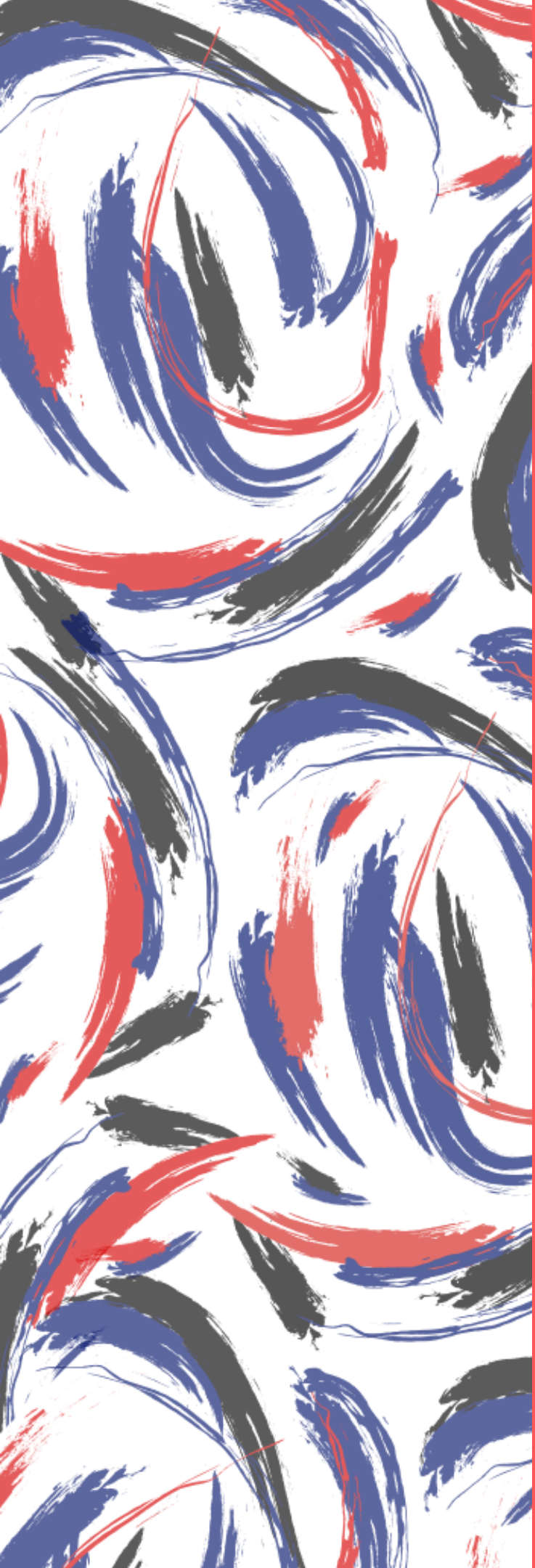
To ask the profession

DO / DOES

Where do you work?

I'm a teacher. I work in a school.

What do they have?

They have money.

How does she run so fast?

She runs so fast because she trains a lot.

Does he have a diploma?

No, he has not a diploma. No he hasn't a diploma.



The Family

Is his **father** there? → No, only his **mother**
father = dad **mother = mom** **parents**

Does your **brother** live with you? →
Yes, but my **sister** lives with her **husband**.

Is your **(great) grandfather** alive? Yes, he lives
with my **grandmother**.

GRANDPARENTS

grandpa = grandfather grandmother = grandma

The Family

Do you see your **uncle**? → No, only my **aunt**.

Are your **cousins** your friends? → Yes, I love them

Is your brother **married**? → Yes, I have a sister-in-law.

Is your sister single? → Yes, I don't have a **brother-in-law**.



The Family

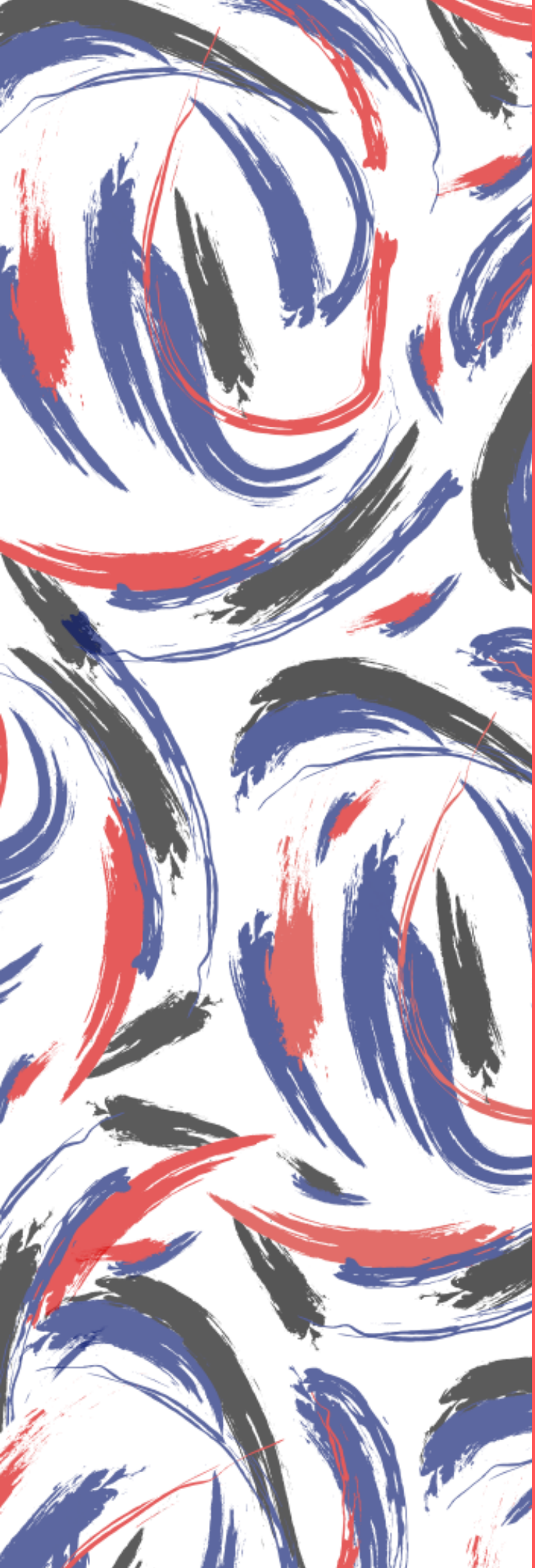
Do you have children? → Yes, I have a **daughter** and a **son**.

Are they **married**? → My son is married, so I have a **daughter-in-law**. However, my **daughter** is divorced, so I don't have a **son-in-law**.

How many **nephews** do you have? → I don't have nephews, only **nieces**.

Do you have grandchildren? → Yes, I have a **granddaughter** and a **grandson**.

This is the car of **X** my brother.

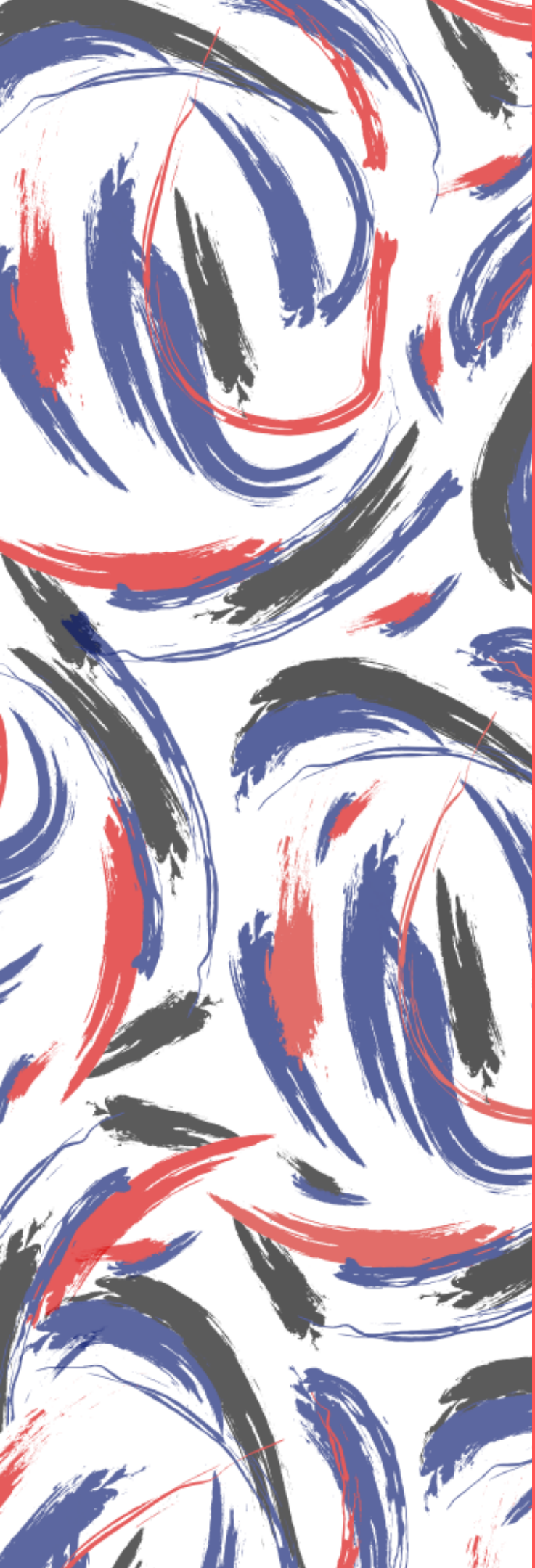
