**Used in:** expressar existência/ equivale ao verbo HAVER ou EXISTIR em Português.

### STRUCTURE:

- ⊕ There is a big TV here in the studio.  
There are a lot of students downstairs.
- ⊖ There isn't a big TV here in the studio.  
There aren't a lot of students downstairs.
- ❓ Is there a big TV here in the studio?  
Are there a lot of students downstairs?

## HAVE X THERE IS / THERE ARE

em Português nós usamos:

- ▶ Tem muita cadeira para os fãs sentarem e assistirem ao jogo no estádio.

em Inglês o verbo TO HAVE indica somente posse e precisa de um sujeito:

- ▶ There are lots of chairs for the fans to seat and watch the game.
- ▶ The stadium has lots of chairs for the fans to seat and watch the game.
