#### How to make a 911 call

- 4. Remember, do not hang up the phone. Stay on the line as long as needed.
- 5. Tell the operator who else is with you and if anyone is hurt or not breathing because they are unconscious.
- 6. Decide if you need an ambulance, and tell the operator if you do.
