

**AULA 14**  
**INTERROGATIVOS**  
(Pronomes e Advérbios)

**TEORIA**

As “*Interrogative Words*” podem ser divididas em: “*Interrogative Pronouns*” e “*Interrogative Adverbs*”.

**1. PRONOMES INTERROGATIVOS**

Os “*Interrogative Pronouns*” são usados para formular perguntas sobre peçoas ou coisas.

PRONOME	USO
WHO	Refere-se a pessoas e exerce a função de sujeito. “ <i>Who discovered America?</i> ”
WHOM	Refere-se a pessoas e exerce a função de objeto. “ <i>To whom did you give the money?</i> ”
WHAT	Utilizado para perguntas com um grande número de respostas possíveis. “ <i>What is your favorite color?</i> ”
WHICH	Utilizado para demonstrar possibilidade de escolha. “ <i>Which season of the year do you prefer?</i> ”
WHOSE	Utilizado para expressar posse. “ <i>Whose glasses are these?</i> ”

**2. ADVÉRBIOS INTERROGATIVOS**

Os “*Interrogative Adverbs*” são palavras usadas para formular perguntas relacionadas ao tempo, lugar, razão ou modo.

ADVÉRBIO	USO
WHEN	Utilizado para fazer perguntas sobre tempo. “ <i>When did they arrive?</i> ”
WHERE	Utilizado para fazer perguntas sobre lugar. “ <i>Where does he live?</i> ”
WHY	Utilizado para fazer perguntas sobre a causa de algo. “ <i>Why is she crying?</i> ”
HOW	Utilizado para fazer perguntas sobre o modo. “ <i>How did you do that?</i> ”

**3. FORMAS COMPOSTAS DE “HOW”**

O advérbio interrogativo “*how*” pode se combinar com outras palavras (adjetivos ou advérbios) para formular perguntas ainda mais específicas.

FORMAS	EXEMPLOS
HOW MANY	<i>How many students are there?</i>
HOW MUCH	<i>How much money do you have?</i>
HOW OLD	<i>How old is she?</i>
HOW FAR	<i>How far is your house from here?</i>
HOW TALL	<i>How tall is your brother?</i>
HOW HIGH	<i>How high is this building?</i>
HOW OFTEN	<i>How often do you study English?</i>
HOW DEEP	<i>How deep is this pool?</i>
HOW WIDE	<i>How wide is that room?</i>
HOW LONG	<i>How long is this road?</i> <i>How long do you intend to stay here?</i>
